Applying for settled status can be confusing. **Settled** can give you good advice and answer any questions you may have. For instance...

- Am I eligible for settled status or pre-settled status?
- What documents do I need?
- What can I do if I don't have all these documents?
- What if I don't have a smartphone or a computer?
- What if I've lived in the UK for less than five years?


